The papers of William R. Stocking, Jr., teacher and coach at Detroit Central High School, were placed in the Wayne State University Archives by Mrs. William Stocking in July, 1960.

William Stocking, Jr. came to Detroit in 1908 to be a teacher and coach at Central High School on Cass Avenue. Born in Wissacasset, Maine in 1881, Stocking received his M.A. from Williams College of Williamstown, Massachusetts in 1905. Through the coaching of Stocking, Central's athletic teams achieved great distinction. Central's football team held the title of State Champion in 1910 and 1913 and claimed to be the 1910 Midwestern High School Champion. Stocking also coached basketball, 1911 State Champions, baseball and taught English at Central.

In 1913, Stocking retired from active coaching to become house principle and subsequently assistant principle at Central. From Central High School, he assumed the duties of principle of Southeastern High School in 1926 and became Redford High School principle in 1941. William Stocking, Jr. died at the age of 68 in 1949.

Throughout his career as an educator and school administrator. Stocking was active in numerous organizations - The National Education Association, Michigan Education Association, Detroit Teacher's Association, Detroit Schoolman's Club, Vocational Guidance Association and the Michigan Schoolmaster's Club - and served as president for several. Stocking was also an active member of the Christian Science Church.

The papers of William R. Stocking, Jr., generally reflect the work of an active innovative educator. Specifically the papers reflect his activities at Detroit Central High School from 1908 to 1913, and the high regard which the faculty and students of Central had for Stocking.
