The papers of the Ted Andras were placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs in April of 1992 by Mr. Andras and were opened for research in February of 1993.

Ted Andras was a member of the staff of radio station WDET-FM, the pioneer radio station of the United Auto Workers (UAW) established in Detroit, Michigan in the late forties. He later served in the Education Division of the UAW.

The papers of Mr. Andras consist of correspondence, license applications, construction permits, and engineering exhibit applications relating to the construction of radio station WDET-FM.
