The Developing Urban Detroit Area Research Project (UDA) Collection was placed in the Archives of Labor History and Urban Affairs in 1973 by the Detroit Edison Company and was open for research in 1975.

UDA was conceived by Walker L. Cisler, Chairman of the Board of the Detroit Edison Company. Begun in 1964, the project was sponsored by Detroit Edison and Wayne State University. Doxiadis Associates, an international urban planning organization headed by Constantinos A. Doxiadis, was selected to undertake the project. The stated aim of UDA from the beginning was "an understanding of the problems created by dynamic urban growth in the Detroit Area and an exploitation of methods by which these problems can be faced successfully in the future." In the seven year history of the project, 1964-1972, a team of planners from Doxiadis Associates working in Detroit collected and created large amounts of written and graphic data. The series of this collection represent the most important subdivisions of this material.

The principal findings of UDA were published in three volumes, collectively titled Emergence and Growth of an Urban Region. Copies of the work have been placed in the Archives Library. Substantially more written material produced by the project may be found in Series V. The collection as a whole preserves a record of the organization and evolution of the project.

Coordinate with UDA were two other research projects, a study of larger urban patterns affecting the region, the Great Lakes Megalopolis (GLM) and a study of the greater Cleveland area, the Northern Ohio Urban System (NOUS). Printed materials from both GLM and NOUS may be found in Series V.

Reports on the major findings of the first phase of the studies, the scope of which is to analyze the size and nature of the dynamic urban growth in the area influenced by Detroit, to understand the many problems created by this dynamic development, and to explore methods by which these difficulties can be alleviated in the future.

- 37-7. Basic Feasibility Considerations, All-Electric City, Report No. 2 DOX-USA-A 13 Sept. 1965
A study of the feasibility of creating the All-Electric City, as far as possible, without having a specific site selected. It summarizes the different elements that will determine the feasibility of the Project, showing direct and indirect benefits to be derived from it, and recommends further action and studies to be undertaken.
- 37-8. A Progress Report on Phase "B" DOX-USA-A 15 Dec. 1965
A short account of the progress in trying to compare the future ekistic picture of the UDA and how urban development could be better guided than by projecting the present trends. Also examines other factors that might influence development, and gives a sample of the research work which is being done.
- 37-9. The Developing Urban Detroit Area Research Project, Part Two - Future Alternatives - Interim Report DOX-USA-A 17 March 1966
Gives the findings of the second phase of the studies being carried out within the framework of the Research Project for the developing Urban Detroit Area. Explains the methodology which is being followed in the present research phase. A set of assumptions referring to the basic magnitudes that will condition development are put forward.
- 37-10. Work Frame and Program of Studies for the Developing Urban Detroit Area Research Project - 1967 DOX-USA-A 20 Jan. 1967
A general program gives an enumeration of the studies intended to be covered during the whole period (i.e., during 1967). For the first six months only, a detailed timetable of work is formulated and the items proposed to be studied are given.

A continuation of DOX-USA-A 19 and DOX-USA-A 23 reports; its purpose is to replace the theoretical networks by networks adjusted to each alternate development solution and to include accessibility forces other than those to and from work.
- 37-15. Conservation of Natural Resources in UDA DOX-USA-A 29 July 1967
This preliminary report sets out a possible methodology for the study of the conservation of natural resources in the UDA, focusing on land, water and air conservation. It examines such aspects relating to its implementation as the time required for completion of the study and the organization of the Project as a whole.

An account of the research work carried out for the purpose of elaborating on the findings of the second phase at the UDA scale. This elaboration on and reevaluation of the seven alternatives is the result of the refinements in the methods and techniques employed in the UDA study.
- 37-19. UDA Research Project - The Higher Order Transportation Networks of Alternative 120 DOX-USA-A 34 Jan. 1968
A first step in the more detailed work on the elaboration of specific phenomena of the selected Alternative 120. It further adjusts the theoretical higher-order networks of this alternative and computes the final theoretical distribution of population and employment in the study area. The adjusted transportation networks are used to develop the final theoretical grid of higher-order transportation networks at this stage of study.

A continuation of the report, DOX-USA-DT 4, which dealt with the total evolution of the developing Urban Detroit Area Megalopolis. Includes a more detailed account on the proposed programs of action.
- 37-23. Program UDA-G-OV - UDA-Overall Development 1 - Preliminary Considerations on Physical Structure DOX-USA-A 42 May 1968
This is a first step toward the formulation of an overall program in as meaningful operational terms as possible. A preliminary development plan is drawn for the UDA which shows the general physical structure of the area in the year 2000 (according to Alternative 120) and attempts to clarify the spatial relationship of the various items in order to facilitate the understanding of their functional interrelation.
- 37-24. Program UDA-G-TL - UDA-Land Transportation 1 - Preliminary Definition of Regional and Metropolitan Networks DOX-USA-A 43 May 1968
A further step in the preliminary definition of the Regional and Metropolitan transportation networks. Focuses on the national transportation setting as derived from the study of the broader USA and GLM scales and the sketch development plan for the UDA presented in DOX-USA-A 42. Summarizes previous work carried out on the transportation system for the UDA.
- 37-25 UDA-Water Transportation 1 - The New Port - Preliminary Consideration on its Location DOX-USA-A 44 May 1968
A first step in a program of study leading to the creation of a new major port at a suitable location in the St. Clair River area in accordance with the planning targets of Alternative 120. Contains preliminary estimates of future requirements.

- 37-26. Program UDA-G-TA - UDA-Air Transportation DOX-USA-A 45 May 1968
1 - The New Airport - Preliminary Consideration
on its Location
 Preliminary first steps in the program of study for the creation of a new major airport as suggested by Alternative 120. Site to be located in the vicinity of the new urban center in the St. Clair River area.
- 37-27. Program AIV.I-G-OV - AIV.I-Overall Development DOX-USA-A 46 May 1968
1 - Preliminary Considerations on Physical Structure
 This study suggests the physical structure of the densely urbanized part of Subregion IV and the major portion of the development to take place in the wider new urban center area. It is a first step toward the overall development foreseen for that area by Alternative 120. It focuses on refining the various planning phases and elaborating the physical concepts which should shape this development.

Manufacturing Activity in the New Industrial
Center DOX-USA-DT 10 June 1968
A preliminary report which attempts to give a framework of thoughts on possible activities which could be concentrated in the new industrial center. It raises questions and suggests certain courses of action. Further provides tentative orders of magnitude by broad categories of future manufacturing activity in the new center.
- 37-32. Detroit Edison Area in the CBD - A First
Concept for its Revitalization DOX-USA-DT 11 June 1968
A plan to develop a more compatible environment around the Detroit Edison headquarters. Suggests proper mix of residential, office and commercial interests, plus features of safety, recreation and attractiveness.
- 37-33 A Course of Action DOX-USA-DT 12 Sept. 1968
Based on the findings of the UDA studies, this document suggests courses of action at different scales and for different time frames. It is a preliminary look at steps of implementation which should be used only as a basis for discussion.

- 38-1. A Contribution Towards Implementation -
Suggestions for Policies and Programs -
The Nine Targets DOX-USA-A 51 Oct. 1968

This report attempts to formulate the policies and programs needed for implementation of the findings of the UDA Research Project. The proposals made should be considered as preliminary suggestions. It deals with the continuation of the work in the Project and the initiation of steps for implementation.

- 38-2. The UDA Effort - The Substance of Findings of
the UDA Research Project DOX-USA-A 52 Oct. 1968

This document gives a brief summary of the study on the future development of the UDA and outlines the advantages of the selected solution compared to situations which would result from the continuation of present trends. An outline of existing conditions is also portrayed. This document was subsequently superseded by DOX-USA-A 60.

- 38-3. Work Program for the UDA Research Project DOX-USA-A 53 Oct. 1968

A detailed program of work yet to be done to the end of the study period. It aims at organizing and coordinating the available forces so that objectives set in the general program (DOX-USA-DT 12) can be realized. Shows the relation of the proposed program to the overall Project and the tentative detailed work program and how the Detroit Edison team, which will take over the Project's responsibilities, should be related to the future work program.

- 38-4. The Detroit Edison Team for the UDA Research
Project DOX-USA-A 54 Oct. 1968

Recommendations regarding the organization, function, composition, recruiting and training of the Detroit Edison team which will be formed to take over the UDA Project's activities at the conclusion of the research phases.

- 38-5. A Program for Special Studies for the UDA Re-
search Project DOX-USA-A 55 Oct. 1968

This report discusses some special needs associated with the UDA study that should be met by additional specific research. These studies would be in support of assumptions made to date concerning the selection of Alternative 120. Needs are analyzed and proposals are made with regard to the mobilization of a number of authorities in specific fields of urban development.

- 38-6. The UDA Effort - The Substance of Findings of the DOX-USA-A 58 Dec. 1968
UDA Research Project (Revised Edition)
A continuation of DOX-USA-A 52, with a somewhat more detailed elaboration on the findings of the UDA Research Project. Summarizes how Detroit is today, where Detroit is going and where Detroit should go. It is another preliminary document to DOX-USA-A 60, which supersedes it.
- 38-7. Work Program for the UDA Research Project DOX-USA-A 59 Dec. 1968
(Revised Edition)
A revised edition of DOX-USA-A 53. A further breakdown has been made of the detailed program and follows the same basic strategy in tackling the various items of the study, as did DOX-USA-A 53. It differs from it in a general prolongation of the initial steps of the program in the early months of 1969. Includes scheduling timetable.
- 38-8. The Urban Detroit Area Effort - The Substance of Findings of the UDA Research Project DOX-USA-A 60 Jan. 1969
This report deals with the same problems as DOX-USA-A 52 and 58. The subject matter concerns the existing conditions in Detroit, the present trends and where Detroit should go, at three different scales of study.
- 38-9 Analysis of Residential Communities in the Critical Area (Revised Edition) DOX-USA-DT 13 Feb. 1969
Identifies the community structure within an area roughly half the City of Detroit (called the Critical Area for reasons defined in the report). Compares and evaluates the various communities for the establishment of priorities for action. Points out those areas which suffer from the greatest ills and delineates the community structure within those areas.
- 38-10. The Revitalization of the Detroit CBD DOX-USA-DT 14 Feb. 1969
(Revised Edition)
A definition of the functions that could be concentrated and the area which would be occupied by a revitalized CBD. Attempts to establish, in a preliminary way, the employment that could be concentrated and the area that should be occupied by the revitalized CBD of the year 2000.

Proposes a plan for the development of the Detroit Edison properties located in the Central Business District of Detroit. What can be done to stimulate development of the area adjacent to the properties and ultimate revitalization of the Detroit CBD. Includes projections on Edison's needs within the area and provides phasing to meet these requirements.
- 38-12. Outline of Studies Provided in the Work Program DOX-USA-A 62 Feb. 1969
A general description of each study included in the work program (DOX-USA-A 59). It outlines the objectives of each study and defines the depth to which studies should extend and the aspects on which greater emphasis should be given.
