In 1968, the Citizens' Crusade Against Poverty merged with several other organizations to form the non-profit Center for Community Change. It began operations by working with six community groups: Mississippi Action for Community Education, the National Farm Workers Service Center, The East Los Angeles Community Union, the Watts Labor Community Action Committee, The Woodlawn Organization (Chicago), and the North Jersey Community Union.

The Center provides a wide range of assistance in program and organizational development for local community development groups in low-income communities, both urban and rural, including resource development, technical assistance, lobbying, research, and the design of social programs —health, hunger and malnutrition, early childhood education, manpower, housing—for grass roots community organizations associated with the Center. In addition to its drive to promote self-sufficient community organizations in impoverished African-American, Latino, Native American and white communities, the Center also focuses national attention on issues dealing with human poverty and works to make government more responsive to the needs of the poor.
