Florence Kuhn began her training at the Detroit Normal School in 1917. She graduated from the College of Education of Wayne University in 1929 and received her Masters of Science in 1935. Teaching and school administration have been her lifes' work. She has been president of the Detroit Teachers College Alumni Association and a member of the Board of Directors of the Wayne University Alumni Association. She became assistant superintendent of the Detroit Public Schools in 1955. Also in that same year, she received W.U. Alumni Award.
